Role of Project Engineer at RPD

A *Project Engineer* could work for multiple *Project Managers* on multiple projects at one time and/or could be pulled in to help with a project estimate.

In our context, the path to *Project Management* is through *Project Estimating* and *Project Engineering*, providing training and support while learning the cost and acquisition side of the job, then transitioning to an assistant *Project Management* role. The goal is to cross-train candidates in both capacities while they learn our business and culture, prior to actually running work.
